Background

The Monroe County Water Authority is removing an underground booster pump station that was constructed in 1968 that is at the end of its useful service life. The station is located on Allens Creek Road in the Town of Brighton.

Project Details

The partially buried booster pump station or vault will be demolished and removed by a Contractor that is qualified to complete the work. Bushes that currently hide the above ground portion of the vault will also be removed from the site.

Service Information

The scheduled work will not affect water quality as the vault has been properly isolated from the water system.

Schedule

We anticipate the contractor starting work in early November and completing the demolition in about two weeks' time. Final lawn restoration will be completed in the spring of 2025.
