WHAT YOU BRING

This position is responsible for operation, maintenance and troubleshooting of surface water and groundwater water treatment plants including:

- Operating computerized monitoring and control system
- Performing routine calculations related to plant operations and water quality analysis and data entry into LIMS system
- Adjusting, filling and/or actuating chemical fields
- Changing chlorine cylinders
- Operating pumps, valves, filters and other equipment related to the plant's operation
- Performing routine laboratory tests
- Making regular periodic security and operating checks of the treatment and pumping facilities
- Making emergency repairs
- Maintaining logs and answering telephones
- Other duties, as assigned

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

For Water Treatment Plant Operator

High school or equivalency diploma plus one (1) year paid full-time experience in the operation of a water treatment plant with facilities for filtration and possession of a Grade II-A treatment plant operator license issued by New York State Health Department at time of appointment.

For Water Treatment Plant Operator Trainee

High school or equivalency diploma.

SCHEDULE

This position requires working a rotating shift including holidays and 12-hr/day weekend duty at various plant locations.
