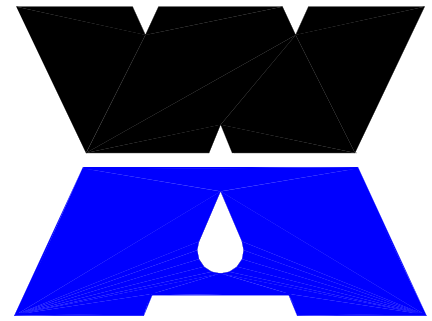

WWTP High Duty Pump #3 Motor Rehabilitation

The project generally consists of the removal, rehabilitation, and reinstallation of the 1000 HP vertical motor, at the Webster Water Treatment Plant, located in The Town of Webster.
