MONROE COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY WARNS RESIDENTS OF FRAUDULENT WORKERS

The Monroe County Water Authority (MCWA) has been made aware that individuals are falsely claiming to be MCWA employees or subcontractors in order to gain access to a customer's home.

If anyone comes to your residence claiming to be a worker associated with the Water Authority, residents should follow these safety tips:

- Check for an employee picture identification badge and a Water Authority "WA" logo on either the jacket or shirt. Legitimate employees and subcontractors will show you their picture ID.
- Check for a blue truck or van with the Water Authority's "WA" logo

If the individual cannot provide the proper identification **DO NOT ALLOW ENTRY and CALL 911** to report the incident. Residents are also asked to make a follow-up call to the Monroe County Water Authority at one of these numbers:
