

1. <u>Personnel Items</u> (Memorandums enclosed):

- <u>Promotional Appointment of Jason Bellows to the title of Instrument/Control System Specialist in Production/Transmission</u>. Mr. Bellows has worked for the Authority in Production/Transmission for 8 years and has been working with the SCADA network. His strong work ethic and leadership qualities, as well as interpersonal and decision-making skills, make him a good fit for this position.
- Promotional Appointment of Joseph Curley to the title of Electrical and Instrumentation Mechanic I. Mr. Curley has been a member of our electrical group in the Production/Transmission department since 2016. He has the skills and talent to excel in this position
- Appointment of Michele Cleary to the title of Programmer Analyst. Ms. Cleary has over twenty years of Information Technology experience, most recently working at Excellus Blue Cross/Blue Shield.
- There is an item on the Agenda to authorize the purchase of various new Tires and Related Services from Lewis General Tires, Inc. through New York State Contract for through the contract period ending March 31, 2024.
- 3. There is an item on the Agenda to authorize the purchase of Ford Vehicle Parts and/or Supplies, ordered as needed utilizing Monroe County Contract from Emerling Ford, Inc through the contract period ending July 31, 2022.
- 4. There is an item on the Agenda to authorize the purchase of one new 2022 Ford F250 Super Duty XL 4 Wheel Drive 6' 34" Standard Box through New York State Office of General Services Vehicle Marketplace from Van Bortel Ford, Inc.
- 5. There is an item on the Agenda to authorize the purchase of Two New 2022 Conventional Day Cabs with 12 Foot Dump Body from Regional Truck and Trailer.

- 6. There is an item on the Agenda to authorize the purchase of one New 2022 Ford F450 4 Wheel Drive Regular Cab with Knapheide Body utilizing the New York State Office of General Service Vehicle Marketplace from Beyer Ford, LLC.
- 7. There is an item on the Agenda to authorize purchase of four new chemical metering pumps and appurtenances, including parts to retrofit ten existing chemical metering pumps, from Watson-Marlow, Inc. The new pumps and appurtenances will be installed at the Shoremont Water Treatment Plant as part of improvements to the sodium hydochlorite disinfection systems. The Authority standardized on the use of Watson-Marlow, Inc. chemical pumps in July 2019 in accordance with Board Authorization #19-143.
- 8. There is an item on the Agenda to award a contract for furnishing and delivering one 500-horsepower (HP) motor to replace the Pump No.2 motor at the Lee Road Booster Pump Station. Four responsive bids were received as presented below.



It is recommended to award this contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Pioneer Pump Systems, Inc. for the bid amount of \$90,989.00

9. There is an item on the Agenda to authorize the purchase nine new Dell Servers and associated equipment with a five-year warranty. These servers will replace end of life infrastructure on both the business and SCADA networks, effectively enhancing performance and providing greater system uptimes.

Attached are the results of the bid opening on July 29, 2021, for the above contract. The contract involves furnishing and delivering one 500 HP motor for the Lee Road Booster Pump Station. Three suppliers submitted bids ranging from \$90,989.00 to \$128,510.00. The Engineer's estimate was \$87,998.00. A bid tabulation sheet is attached. Pioneer Pump Systems, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive responsible bid.

There were minor informalities in the bids that did not affect the ranking.

Pioneer Pump Systems, Inc. is from Syracuse, NY and has supplied pump station equipment for the Authority in the past.

Based on Pioneer Pump Systems, Inc.'s past performance with the Water Authority, it is my recommendation that the Board authorize the Executive Director, to award this unit price contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Pioneer Pump Systems, Inc. for the bid amount of \$90,989.00.
