Beach Avenue Water Main Replacement  
Tree Removal**

**Background**

The Water Authority will be cutting and trimming existing trees and bushes within permanent easements and the right-of-way area of Beach Avenue and Dewey Avenue. This bulletin explains the upcoming work, and identifies whom to contact if you have any questions while the work is being done.

**Project Details**

**Why is this Project needed?** The Water Authority has a yearly program of renewing or replacing existing water mains. This year's program includes the water main on Beach Avenue between Dewey Avenue and Edgemere Drive. Prior to the upcoming water main installation, it will be necessary to cut and trim trees and bushes located along the proposed pipeline route.

**Where is the project located?** The proposed pipeline will be installed on both the north and south side of Beach Avenue, located within permanent easement and within the county and town right-of-ways.

**Replacements?** New trees will be installed as coordinated between the property owners and the Water Authority.

**Schedule**

Our expectations are for the tree clearing work to take place starting the week of February 23<sup>rd</sup> (weather depending) and be completed by the end of March.

The proposed water main installation schedule depends on several factors, but we anticipate our contractor starting work late winter / early spring. As we approach actual construction, additional information will be provided to properties within the project limits and will also be available on our website (MCWA.com).

**Questions**

The clearing work will be performed by a contractor hired by the Water Authority. We will have a Water Authority inspector onsite for this work. All Water Authority workers carry a photo ID card, wear MCWA uniforms, and drive a vehicle with a Water Authority logo on it.
