| 1. I am submitting a Freedom of Information Law request ("FOIL request") to the Monroe County Water Authority ("Authority") pursuant to New York State Public Officers Law. |
| 2. My FOIL request involves a list of names of members of the public and their home addresses, and/or records containing such names and home addresses that could be used to compile such a list. |
| 3. I understand that pursuant to New York State Public Officers Law, the Authority has the right to deny my FOIL request if it involves a list of names and addresses of members of the public and such list would be used for commercial or fund-raising purposes. See Public Officers Law § 89(2)(b)(iii). |
| 4. I understand that pursuant to New York State PUBLIC OFFICERS LAW, the Authority also has the right to deny my FOIL request even if I do not request a list of names and addresses per se if my request for records would be used to develop a list of names and addresses to be used for commercial or fundraising purpose. <i>See Scott, Sardano & Pomeranz v. Records Access Officer of Syracuse</i> , 65 N.Y.2d 294, 491 N.Y.S.2d 289 (1985). |

I will not use the requested (i) list of names and addresses of members of the public and/or (ii) records containing such names and addresses, for commercial or fundraising purposes or to develop a list of names and addresses of members of the public to be used for commercial or fundraising purposes. |
