MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Bachelor's degree in Civil, Mechanical, Electrical Sanitary or Construction Engineering/Technology **plus** four (4) years paid experience in civil engineering work involving drafting, surveying, construction inspection, project design, and public works construction, two (2) years of which must have been in a supervisory capacity.

Associate's degree in Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Sanitary or Construction Engineering/Technology plus six (6) years paid experience in civil engineering work involving drafting, surveying, construction inspection, project design and public works construction; two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.
