JOB DESCRIPTION

This is an entry level unskilled position at the Monroe County Water Authority, involving a variety of routine heavy and light manual labor tasks, performed under direct supervision of a foreman. The job requires physical endurance and employees may be required to work outdoors in all kinds of weather, to work overtime, and to be on 24-hour call, seven days a week, for emergencies.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES

- Assists with installation, maintenance, repair and cleaning of water system components
- Shovels, rakes and tamps asphalt
- Digs and refills trenches for water lines
- Excavates and backfills for new construction and repairs
- Directs traffic on road projects
- May drive pick-up truck or other light vehicle
- May assist a mechanic with equipment
- May operate telephone or two-way radio for emergency dispatching

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS
