TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES

Work as part of a two-man crew and assist in large meter repair, large meter replacements, large meter field testing, field investigations and new meter installations.

Assists in setting of meters and backflow devices for temporary services, seasonal accounts and hydrant use.

Perform various tasks at Meter Services Shop and warehouse building. Duties may include, but not limited to, stocking meters and supply shelves, rebuilding and bench testing seasonal meters, breaking down scrap meters and parts, cleaning and general upkeep of shop, garage and meter warehouse.

Perform all aspects of meter reading duties when needed.
