Pavilion Water Storage Tank Demolition

As part of Monroe County Water Authority's tank maintenance program, The Pavilion Water Storage Tank will be removed this year with work starting in August. A project map showing the tank location is provided on the back of this bulletin.

This bulletin is designed to explain the upcoming work, as well as whom to contact if you have any questions while the work is being completed.

Why does MCWA remove water tanks?

Water tanks become obsolete when they reach their end of service life or when the population they serve has outgrown their available supply. In this case, both of the criteria for removal have been met.

How will this tank be "demolished" safely?

This particular tank will be taken down piece by piece. Starting from the top, pieces will be cut and dropped safely into the bottom of the tank.

How will this affect my water supply?

This tank has not been in service for many years. You will not see any changes in water pressure or flow due to this work.

How long will the work take?

Tank removal will take place in August. All restoration of the work area will be complete by the end of September.

What will the property look like after the Project is complete?

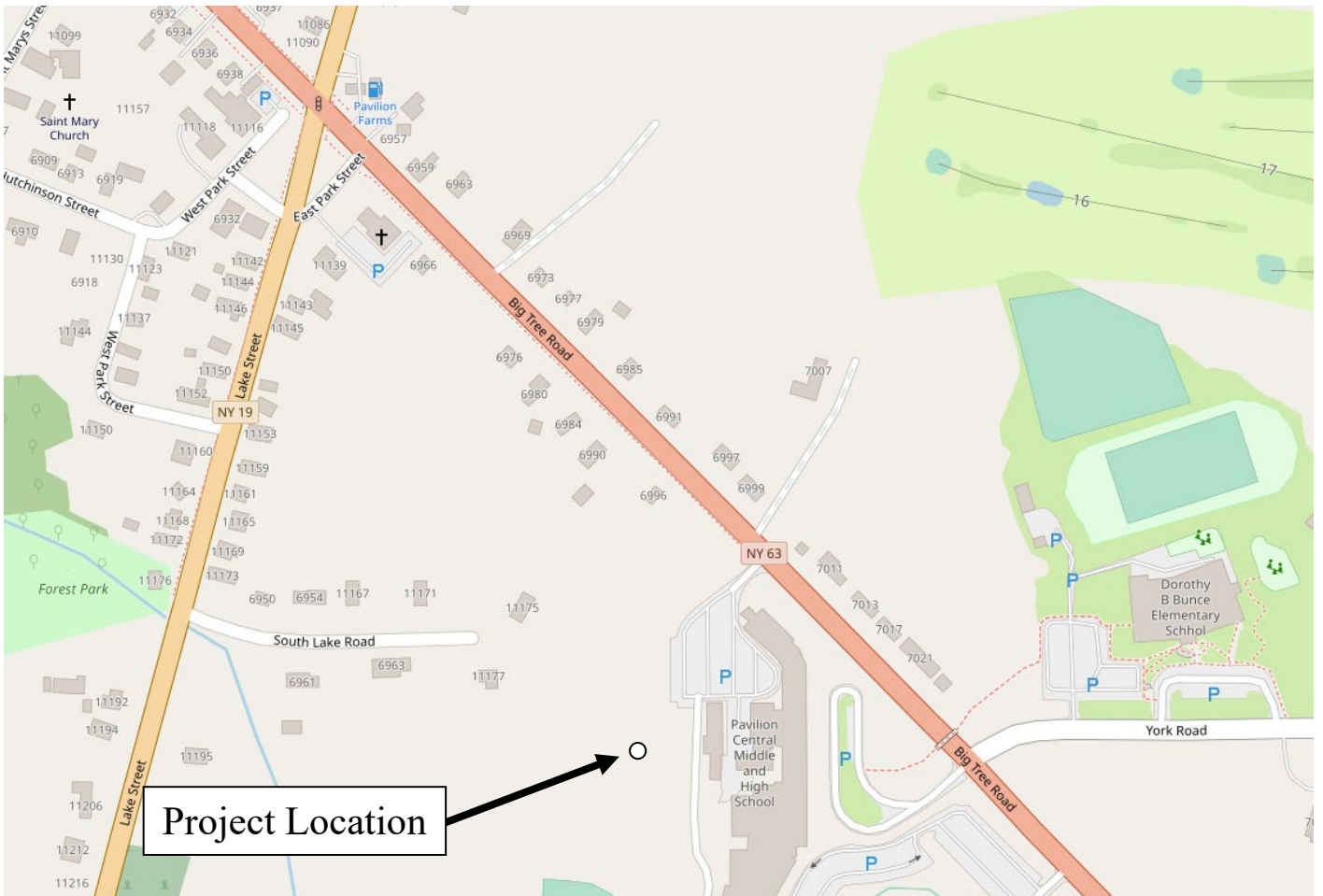
Restoration will include grading of the site and filling all holes created from the removal of foundations with clean fill. Topsoil will be brought in and grass will be seeded.

Whom should I contact if I have questions?

A Water Authority inspector will be on-site throughout the project. All of our inspectors carry a photo ID card, wear Water Authority uniforms, and drive a vehicle with a Water Authority logo on it.
